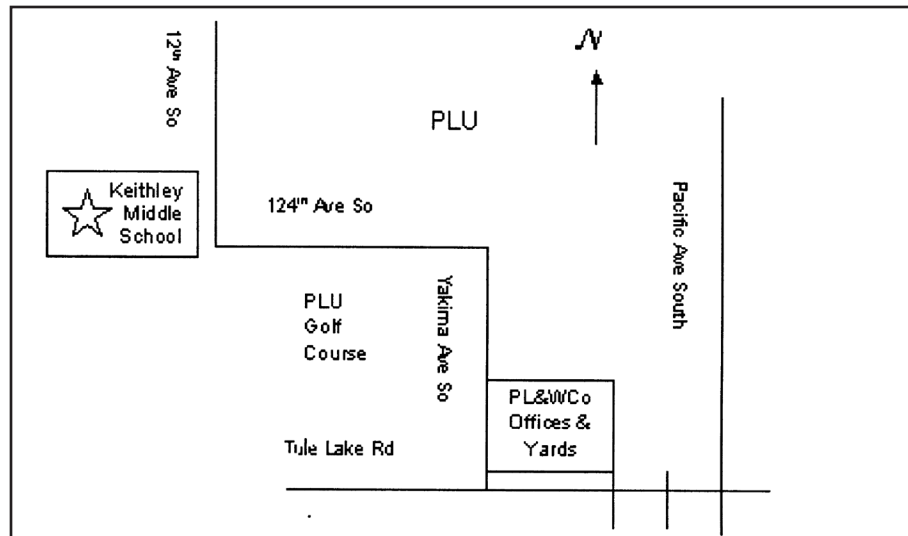
Chuck's excellent administrative, organizational and communication skills make him an asset to the board.
