

Dear Customer/Member:

Parkland Light & Water Company is sending this notice to inform you of a scheduled electric outage that will take place on Sunday, March 21, 2010 that will affect your residence/business electric service. The scheduled outage will begin at 08:00am and will last between five to eight hours. We would expect your electric service to return to normal between 1:00pm and 4:00pm.

If you are a customer that has medical support equipment that is dependent on electricity, you will need to be ready to implement your back-up plan to maintain the use of the equipment just as you would during an extended unscheduled electric outage such as may occur during a wind storm.

Parkland Light & Water Co water service will not be affected.

In our effort to keep rates low and insure that Parkland Light & Water Co's electrical system will remain reliable, it is necessary to have this outage at this time. Our Electric Line Section has been working with high voltage contractors since the first of January to make much needed repairs and maintenance to our thirty one year old John Curtis Substation. In order to complete the repairs safely, the substation must be de-energized. We realize that there is no perfect time for an electrical outage either planned or unplanned. However, everyone would agree that planning an outage and making the necessary repairs to the substation is more efficient and results in shorter outage times than unplanned outages from lack of maintenance.

On behalf of the Parkland Light & Water Company, Board of Directors and Staff, we thank you for your patience and understanding. We look forward to continuing to serve you with one of the lowest cost, most reliable electric and water service possible in western Washington.
